Environmental Information Regulations 2004

I refer to your request for information received by the Department that sought information about tree felling at Manor House Hotel and Caravan Park, Killadeas, Co. Fermanagh:

“Can we please get a copy of all of the felling licences and their conditions for the sites we have reported? Please include a map of each felling licence parcel.”,

I can advise that the Department has completed its search and can confirm that it holds all the information you requested.

However, the Department has decided not to disclose some of the information you requested as it considers Regulation 12(3) 13(1) to be engaged.

Some of the information held constitutes personal data of which you are not the data subject. In these instances, the Department is required to consider if disclosure would breach the first Data Protection Principle, which states that processing must be lawful, fair and transparent.

The Department has considered this element within the test attached and has determined that no lawful basis for disclosure under EIR exists. Please bear in mind that any disclosure must be considered in terms of disclosure to the “world at large” and not just to you, the requester. Consequently, third party personal data falling within the scope of this request has been withheld.

There are four relevant felling licences as identified in our response to DAERA/23-428. These are:

- Felling Licence Reference: FL2022/23-76
- Felling Licence Reference: FL2022/23-79
- Felling Licence Reference: FL2019/20-34
- Felling Licence Reference: FL2022/23-50

Information in respect of the four felling licence applications is provided at annexes one to four. Some information is being withheld. The exception engaged is:

- Regulation 12(3) 13(1) – Personal Data: When information is the personal data of someone other than the applicant, regulation 12(3) requires you not to disclose that personal data, except in accordance with regulation 13.

If you require any clarification, believe that any part of your request has been overlooked, misunderstood or misinterpreted, please contact me in the first instance to see if it is a matter that can be resolved.

If you are unhappy with the manner in which your request for information has been handled or the decision to release/withhold information, you have the right to request a formal review by the Department.

If you wish to do so, please contact The Review Section either by e-mailing daera.informationmanager@daera-ni.gov.uk or by post at The Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs, Data Protection & Information Management Branch, Floor 2, Jubilee House, 111 Ballykelly Road, Ballykelly, Limavady BT49 9HP, within two months from the date of this letter.

If after such an internal review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, CHESHIRE, SK9 5AF, who will undertake an independent review of the Department's decision.
