on 22/02/2024, [REDACTED] and I visited and found run off from cattle feeding area which was at the front of a silage pit area running into a nearby field shore. The area was heavily poached and slurry from the concreted area of the silage clamp where the cattle were being fed was making its way into the drainage shore at the gate and this was then entering another waterway in a field below. I contacted [REDACTED] by email on 23/2/2024 (Email in CM container) asking [REDACTED] to rectify the situation and stop runoff from the area entering the piped drain. There had been similar issue here before and I explained in my email this would likely lead to a breach of cross compliance. Low severity water pollution and pollution confined to drainage shore/ channel that was in and going out of the field and effluent was then ponding in field below
