Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR)

I can advise that the Department has completed its search and can confirm that no waste export permissions are held regarding the above company at the above address, therefore Regulation 12(4)(a) is engaged.

If you are unhappy with the manner in which your request for information has been handled or the decision to release/withhold information, you have the right to request a formal review by the Department.
