### **Environmental Information Regulations 2004**

With regards to your request for information received by this department 14<sup>th</sup> January 2026, made under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, which sought the following information:

- All emails (internal and external)
- Records, notes, or logs of telephone calls
- Internal memoranda, comments, reports, and discussions
- Any other recorded information held in any format

I can advise that the Department has completed its search and can confirm that it holds the information you requested which is attached as **Annex 1**.

Following the completion of a lawfulness, fairness and transparency test, Regulation 12(3) has been applied to redact personal information. Having considered all the information within the test, the department has established that, on balance, there is no lawful basis for the disclosure of third party personal data falling within the scope of the request. has been included. The redactions applied do not affect the substance of the information disclosed.

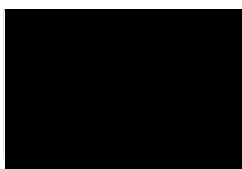

If after such an internal review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, CHESHIRE, SK9 5AF, who will undertake an independent review of the Department's decision.
