We visited the site in response to complaints from 2 residents that wishes to remain anonymous.

We spoke with [REDACTED] and had a walk around the site.

No fly activity noted and the noise from machinery did not appear to be excessive.

**Complaint: bales not being sprayed or operative not having room to spray due to space on lorry.**

[REDACTED] advised that they mainly use a fogger, rather than a sprayer as its easier to reach all parts of the load. Most loads arrive on curtain side trailers; therefore access is straight forward. Not all checking will take place at site entrance, although usually does. Checking sometimes takes place at the rear of the site so he's not sure how residents could witness this. Treatment will only take place if fly activity evident so not all loads require this.

### Overspray:

[REDACTED] said as the complainant wished to remain anonymous, he cannot directly comment on this. He did say that they spray according to wind conditions when required and that should stop spray reaching neighbours gardens. I queried pre-notifying residents when spraying is to take place, [REDACTED] was open to this but not sure how this could take place due to the complainants wish to remain anonymous. I advised of the request from the complainant for the safety data sheet, [REDACTED] said he would prefer if we requested this officially and it would go through the company solicitor.

### Nosie at 2am/3am:

[REDACTED] advised that he would not expect any machinery to kick on at that time but if we could get a more specific time he may be able to check their systems and CCTV to see what it was.

[REDACTED] did say that his site has planning permission and WML for 24-hour operations, even though they do not use it anymore, but have operated 24 hours Monday to Friday in the past. [REDACTED] said that his site does comply with the noise levels on their planning permission and that this has been checked by the local council.

Furthermore, he said if the adjacent houses had been built according to their planning permission, noise may not be an issue. [REDACTED] made reference to the planning enforcement case and retrospective application that is currently being dealt with.

[REDACTED] said it was unfair that anonymous complainants can report him when his facility was compliant with all their planning conditions, but the adjacent housing development wasn't.

Reference was also made to the planning informative regarding prospective residents been made aware that the houses were beside a waste facility and that enforcement of pests/odours and noise from the council cannot be used unless Cherry Pipes intensifies their operation. [REDACTED] they have not intensified.

Concerns were raised about the taking of photos and recording of videos of the site and staff [REDACTED] advised that signs were in place stating that this prohibited.

It was also stated that it seemed unfair, considering local legal and planning issues, that some residents can make complaints anonymously to the [REDACTED]
