We have been informed that due to a system migration issue the 2023 data for TB reporting of confirmed cases. This has now been rectified and won't be a problem going forward, however, 2 lines of data from last years report are incorrect. The figures in red are the revised figures.

Confirmed herds during year	2913	2703
New outbreaks confirmed during year	1792	1628

Can you advise of the best course of action to correct this? Can we get the DCF opened to re-upload and if we need to amend the text document that accompanies this.

Additionally, last week you'd mentioned the 2023 Campylobacter in fattening pigs and Carba testing for 2022 was not available for NI. Could you clarify this for me so I can speak with the SMEs about the data requirements.
