Good Afternoon [REDACTED]

We have identified an issue with the TB Disease Status – the data is not available in the DWH. We believe this is a result of an amendment to the mapping tool that was made following validation. The sampling area was changed from UKN | NORTHERN IRELAND (NUTS level 1) to UKN0 | Northern Ireland (NUTS level 2) following feedback from EFSA.

We were advised that we should amend the data to NUTS level 2, and so replaced the original file with this amendment on the DCF during the validation process.

QUESTIONS RAISED

CRITICAL: sample area name incorrectly used for cattle (it is NUTS level 1 rather than NUTS level 2)

We believe that this instruction was incorrect and are therefore putting a request to have this reviewed to so that Northern Ireland's data can be submitted correctly for TB.
