With regard to your request for information received by the Department on 9 February 2026 which sought the following information:

The most up-to-date data on Cypermethrin levels in Carlingford Lough (the nearest testing site you have to Warrenpoint Harbour if you have more than one) and also comparative information for at least five other sites — coastal or in open loughs (that lead to the sea). Please give me the actual numbers, not just grades such as high, moderate etc.
