This table provides valuations for slow-growing broilers grown as free range 'corn-fed' birds for off-farm processing. It should not be used for standard broilers or for farms with their own processing facilities and direct sales outlets.

Valuations are based on 'as hatched' production with males and females reared together in broadly equal numbers.

If the age of birds exceeds that given in the table, a pro-rata figure should be calculated using the last two valuation points to determine the daily increment.
