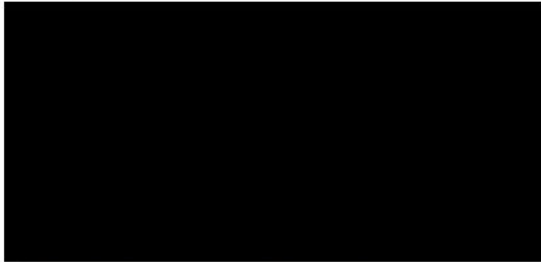

4. There shall be no external storage of waste other than the storage within the external waste storage bays identified on stamped approved drawing No 03 (Rev C) date stamped received 26th March 2009 and that waste shall be restricted to glass (15 01 07, 19 12 05, 20 01 02) and inert materials (17 01 07).

Reason: In the interests of amenity of residents living in the surrounding area and to safeguard public health and the environment.

5. All work activity between 2300 to 0700 hours shall only be carried out within the Materials Recovery Facility building and with the roller shutter doors in the closed position.

Reason: In the interests of amenity of residents living in the surrounding area.

6. The mobile transfer station identified on stamped approved drawing No 03 (Rev C) date stamped received 26th March 2009 shall only be stored on the site and shall not be operated at anytime.

Reason: In the interests of amenity of residents living in the surrounding area.

7. No site works of any nature or development shall take place until a programme of archaeological work has been implemented, in accordance with a written scheme and programme prepared by a qualified archaeologist, submitted by the applicant and approved by the Department. The programme should provide for the identification and evaluation of the archaeological remains within the site, for mitigation of the impacts of the development through excavation recording or by preservation of remains and for the preparation of an archaeological report.

Reason: To ensure that archaeological remains within the application site are properly identified and protected or appropriately recorded.

8. Access shall be afforded to the site at all reasonable times to any archaeologist nominated by the Department to observe the operations and to monitor the implementation of archaeological requirements.

Informatives

If, during the course of developing the site, the developer uncovers a watercourse not previously evident, he should advise the local Rivers Agency office immediately in order that arrangements may be made for investigation and direction in respect of any necessary measures required to deal with the watercourse.
5. The Rivers Agency has no record of flooding occurring at the site and visual inspection indicates that it is unlikely to be affected by general flooding originating from any watercourse(s).
6. Where a Designated watercourse flows through or adjacent to a development site, it is considered essential that a working strip of minimum width 5m is left along the bank in order to facilitate future maintenance of the watercourse by the Rivers Agency. Actual requirement should be determined in consultation with the Agency.

9. Loughs Agency advise that the applicant should demonstrate best environmental practice when working close to watercourses. The potential for deleterious matter to enter a watercourse is of primary concern. Impacts on the aquatic environment such as a decrease in water quality can cause a significant impact upon various life history stages of fish species.
10. Loughs Agency advise that should for any reason, oil or fuel be stored in the area, it must be kept in a bunded area (providing 110% capacity of the largest stored unit), 100m from any watercourse that appears on a 1:10,000 OS map of the site.
11. Loughs Agency advise that it is essential that oil interceptors are utilised and are capable of settling out materials prior to discharge off site. Such interceptors must be regularly inspected and maintained accordingly.
12. Loughs Agency advise that a contingency plan must be established and strictly adhered to in the event of any contamination of watercourses.
13. Loughs Agency advise that the applicant should also be aware that it is an offence under section 41 of the Foyle Fisheries Act (1952) to cause pollution which is detrimental to fisheries interests.

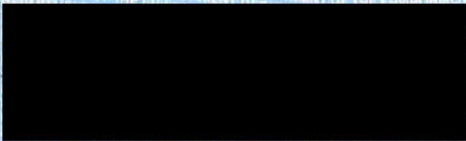

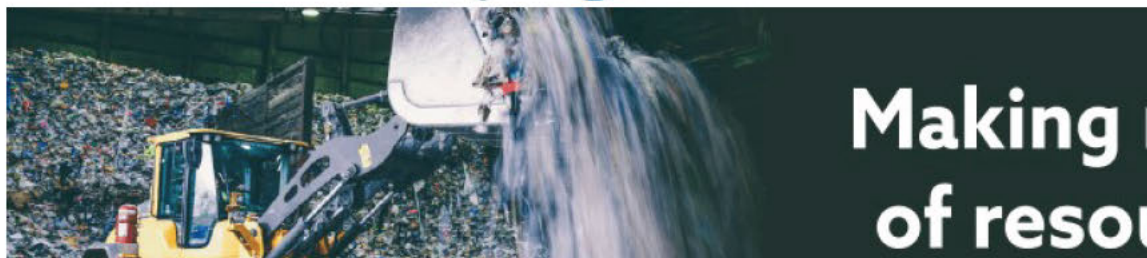

During our inspection of 29 May 2025, a query was raised regarding waste being stored externally in a bay outside of door 5 of the municipal solid waste plant (PPC Permit area) at Shepherds Drive.

We followed this up with an e-mail on 18/07/25, and have yet to receive a response.

NIEA's understanding is planning permission restricts external storage to only:

15.01.07: glass packaging

19.12.05: glass

20.01.02: glass

17.01.07: mixed C&D

Are there any other planning permissions in place that permit the external storage of wastes, other than identified above?

Note the NIEA and NMDDC planning department have recently received reports with images about alleged illegal external storage of waste at the Shepherds Drive facilities. NIEA will be following up specifically on these matters relating to the Permit / Licence through inspection in the coming weeks.
