Additionally, as tonnage to the site is received typically across 10hours each day, the figures below represent a maximum time frame in which they could be held for within the waste reception hall before being processed, the hours listed below represent how long the de-packaging plant is operational, and therefore shows that waste received does not remain unprocessed for extended periods of time. Thanks for taking my call this morning, as discussed, at approx. 6am, AD Tank 1 overflowed (not foaming event) resulting in a spill of approx. 4000-6000l of digestate. Site Management have taken immediate actions to stop the spill. Spill material was fully contained on site and a cleaning operation began immediately – all digestate will be reprocessed in the system.
