

NIEA seek to identify rightful owner/s of a seized JCB 3CX machine.

The Northern Ireland Environment Agency (NIEA) wish to identify the rightful owners or custodian of a yellow coloured JCB 3CX machine. This machine was seized from Chapel Road, Meigh, Newry on 17th May 2022.

The JCB 3CX is described as yellow in colour, and at the time of seizure it bore the registration number 85-LK-507.



The JCB 3CX has been seized as NIEA officers reasonably suspect that an offence(s) under the Waste and Contaminated Land (NI) Order 1997 has been committed and that the JCB 3CX machine was used in the commission of the said offences

NIEA now seeks to establish entitlement to the JCB 3CX machine under regulation 5 of the 2013 Regulations. Accordingly, any person who wishes to claim ownership of the JCB 3CX should contact the NIEA at the address below by 1 May 2026 and provide the appropriate documents to prove ownership.

If proof of ownership is not received by 1 May 2026 NIEA will dispose of the vehicle in accordance with regulation 6(6) of the 2013 Regulations.
