Perimeter Security:

Set back from road, site is enclosed by walls on 3 sides and river on other. Most fish are housed, those outside are fenced.



Tanks, Ponds, Raceways:

(A) 4 round concrete ponds and 4 concrete raceways. - refurbished. (B) 20 fibreglass rearing tanks, 15 concrete raceways, fry troughs and 2 incubators. (C) 6 very large concrete ponds. 3 concrete raceways in fry shed made into one, 2 of these.

Farm / Pond Cover:

(A) nets over all ponds and raceways. (B) (C) housed. Pond outside covered by nets. Fry are housed inside.



Pond inlets/Outlets:

(A) Grids are all in place. (B) and (C) are on enclosed recirculation units.



Feed Storage:

Main store is in brick building where feed is in large plastic tanks off the ground. There are feed bins around site.



Hatchery Condition:

Roof in need of some repair. Equipment etc in excellent condition. Disinfectant footbaths at the entrance and hand gel.

Site Biosecurity:

Operator has a biosecurity plan. Footbaths at the main entrance and entrances to all buildings. Hand sanitiser also available.



Site inlet / outlet:

Inlet is from the Crumlin River and a borehole. Outlet is via the bottom left of the farm and is gridded.
