Environmental Information Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2004

With regard to your request for information received by the Department on 15th April 2026 which sought the following information:

Can I please get the number of complaints that have been made about Granville Industrial Park and then separately Granville Eco Park:

- a) in the year up until February 2026
- b) in the year up until March 2026
- c) each calendar year for the last 5 years
- d) each calendar year for the last 10 years
- e) each calendar year for the last 20 years

Can I have this for overall complaints then separately for odour complaints?

In answer the Department has understood that the facility referred to as Granville Eco Park, is Granville Ecopark Limited, Permit No. P0413 12A. For the purposes of this return searches were limited to March 2026 – January 2016.

Has been applied via a Public Interest Test resulting in the requested information being limited up to and including 10years.

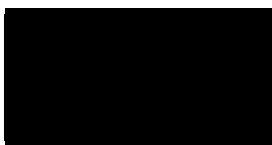
If you are unhappy with the manner in which your request for information has been handled or the decision to release/withhold information, you have the right to request a formal review by the Department.
