### **Environmental Information Regulation 2004**

I refer to your request for information received by the Department on 15 April 2026 that sought the following information:

#### **Request 1 – H4 Odour Assessment Locations and Survey Results**

Please provide the following:

1. A detailed map or plan identifying all common locations used by the NIEA when conducting H4-compliant odour assessments around the NWP Glenside facility, encompassing all wind directions and covering both upwind and downwind monitoring positions used across all odour assessments carried out to date.
2. A list of all odour assessment locations referenced in (1) above, presented in accordance with the H4 methodology matrix, including the reference/designation assigned to each monitoring point.
3. A full breakdown of the results of all odour surveys conducted at the above locations, clearly identifying:

- The date and time of each survey.
- The prevailing wind direction and meteorological conditions recorded.
- The results recorded at each upwind and downwind monitoring location.
- Whether odour was detected beyond the PPC permit red line boundary of the site at any point during any survey; and
- Any instances where odour was confirmed as escaping beyond the PPC permit red line boundary, together with any action taken by the NIEA in response.

### **Request 2 – Site Inspection Reports (Last 24 Months)**

Please provide a detailed breakdown of all site inspection reports produced by the NIEA for the NWP Glenside facility during the 24-month period immediately preceding the date of this request. This should include all facilities on the site covered by waste authorisations, and should specifically include:

4. The date, duration, and scope of each inspection carried out.
5. The full findings recorded in each inspection report.
6. A detailed explanation of any non-compliances identified during any inspection, including:
  - The nature and description of the non-compliance.
  - The permit condition(s) or regulatory requirement(s) breached.
  - Any enforcement action taken or proposed by the NIEA; and
  - The outcome or current status of each recorded non-compliance.

I can advise that the Department has completed its search and can confirm that it holds some of the information you requested and that regulation 6 (form and format) has been applied. This information can be found in the public register using the relevant search criteria <https://www.daera-ni.gov.uk/articles/public-registers>.

Please note, the Department responded to a similar request from you, reference DAERA/25-174, on 08/05/2025. You can find previous odour survey information within that response up to 08/04/2025, which is the date the request was received by the Department.

If you are unhappy with the manner in which your request for information has been handled or the decision to release/withhold information, you have the right to request a formal review by the Department.
