Environmental Information Regulations 2004

I refer to your request for information received by the Department on 18 May 2026 that sought the following information:

Copies of all quarterly compliance returns, and any associated submitted monitoring data, submitted to NIEA by the operator(s) of the following permitted facilities, covering the period **1 January 2025 to 31 March 2026 inclusive** (i.e. Q1 2025 through Q1 2026):

1. **WML 25/59 / LN 13/35** — Warrenpoint Port
2. **P0610/23A** — Derryboy Road (PPC permit)
3. **WML 38/10 / LN 17/16** — Shepherd's Drive
4. **P0418/13A** — Shepherd's Drive (PPC permit)

In relation to any associated (with the quarterly compliance returns) submitted monitoring data, under Regulation 12(4)(a) the Department is excepted from the duty to disclose the information on the grounds that the information sought is not held.

In relation to the ref to WML 25/59 (used in part-specifying authorisation 1), the correct full authorisation reference for LN/13/35 is WML 22/59 LN/13/35. Under Regulation 12(4)(a) the Department is excepted from the duty to disclose the information in respect of WML 25/59 on the grounds that the information sought is not held.

In relation to authorisation nos. 2 and 4, under Regulation 6(1)(b) the Department is excepted from the duty to disclose the information requested relating to the period Q4 2024-25 (Jan-Mar 2025) to Q1 2025-26 (Apr-Jun 2025) on the grounds that this information has already been supplied to you under a previous EIR, DAERA 25/413. We note the repetitive nature of this request.

I can advise that the Department has completed its search and can confirm that it holds some of the information you requested. This information is attached to this emailed reply as DAERA 26-345 data.csv.

If you require any clarification, believe that any part of your request has been overlooked, misunderstood or misinterpreted, please contact me in the first instance to see if it is a matter that can be resolved.

If you are unhappy with the way your request for information has been handled or the decision to release/withhold information, you have the right to request a formal review by the Department. If you wish to do so, please contact The Review Section either by e-mailing daera.informationmanager@daera-ni.gov.uk or by post at The Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs, Data Protection & Information Management Branch, Floor 2, Jubilee House, 111 Ballykelly Road, Ballykelly, Limavady BT49 9HP, within two months from the date of this letter.

If after such an internal review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, CHESHIRE SK9 5AF, who will undertake an independent review of the Department's decision.
