This table provides valuations for organic production, with slow-growing strains of chicken grown for off-farm processing. It should not be used for farms with their own processing facilities and direct sales outlets.

This valuation is based on the use of organic systems and feeds. It assumes that the birds are reared 'as-hatched' i.e. males and females reared together in broadly equal numbers.
