This table provides valuations for laying hens in enriched cages, producing eggs for human consumption. The table is based on brown hybrid strains and is not suitable for white laying hens.

The valuation is based on a maximum age of 86 weeks. If a flock is marginally older than this at the time of the outbreak, the final valuation shown here can still be used. For a younger flock expected to substantially exceed 86 weeks of age, a separate valuation may be required.

For flock ages that do not exactly match the weekly valuation increments, the appropriate pro-rata figure should be calculated.
