This table provides valuations for slow-growing strains of chicken grown for off-farm processing. It should not be used for farms with their own processing facilities and direct sales outlets.

Several different slow-growing strains may be used.

This valuation is based on free range production and non-organic diets. It assumes that the birds are reared 'as-hatched' i.e. males and females together in broadly equal numbers.
