This table provides valuations for standard broilers stocked at 30kg/m² and grown for off-farm processing. It should not be used for slower-growing birds or for farms with their own processing facilities and direct sales outlets.

Most broilers are reared 'as-hatched'.

If the age of birds exceeds that given in the table, a pro-rata figure should be calculated using the last two valuation points to determine the daily increment.
