I refer to your request for information received by the Department on 09 June 2026 as detailed below.

This request relates to **Hollow Park Sand & Gravel Ltd, 9B Crocknamohil Road, Draperstown**, lands west of **Iniscarn Road** and north of **Crocknamohil Road**, and planning application **LA09/2020/0472/F**.

Please confirm and provide the following:

1. Whether any **mobile crushing, screening, washing, processing or mineral-handling plant** operating under a DAERA/NIEA PPC permit has been notified, deployed or operated at this site.
2. If yes, please provide the **operator name, PPC permit number, plant type, dates of deployment/operation, and location notified**.
3. Please provide any **Schedule 3 / location-change / deployment notification**, including any BAT checklist, site-layout sketch, environmental-impact note or sensitive-receptor/ASSI assessment.
4. Please provide any **inspection records, complaints, incident reports, monitoring logs, enforcement records, warning letters or correspondence** connected to mobile plant at this site.

5. Please confirm whether **PHA was involved in any consultation, notification, correspondence, assessment or decision-making** in relation to any such mobile PPC deployment. Please also confirm whether **Mid Ulster District Council, Environmental Health or Planning Enforcement** were notified or consulted.

- DAERA is not responsible for regulating sand and gravel quarries under the Pollution Prevention and Control (Industrial Emissions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2013.
- DAERA has not received any notification of operation of PPC permitted mobile crushing and screening plant at this site.
