Environmental Information Regulations 2004

Regarding your request for information received by the Department on 16th June 2026; please see our response under each question below:

3. *Any NIEA Waste Management response, advice, assessment, determination or correspondence prepared in response to the request from Shared Environmental Service dated 22 May 2026 seeking confirmation that Recon*

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Waste Management Ltd is authorised to accept poultry litter in connection with Planning Application LA09/2025/0873/F.

4. *Any correspondence exchanged between NIEA Waste Management, Recon Waste Management Ltd, Mid Ulster District Council, Shared Environmental Service, the applicant, or their agents concerning the acceptance, management, transport or disposal of poultry litter arising from Planning Application LA09/2025/0873/F.*

Please bear in mind that any disclosure must be considered in terms of disclosure to the “world at large” and not just to you, the requester. Consequently, third party personal data falling within the scope of this request has been withheld.

If you are unhappy with the manner in which your request for information has been handled or the decision to release/withhold information, you have the right to request a formal review by the Department. If after such an internal review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at Wycliffe House, Water Lane,

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Wilmslow, CHESHIRE SK9 5AF, who will undertake an independent review of the Department's decision.
