A3. Clear Water Systems Limited requested the termination on 30th January 2026.

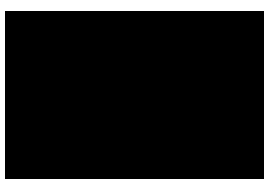
