Environmental Information Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2004

With regard to your request for information received by the Department on 17th June 2026 which sought the following information:

“I would be grateful if NIEA could provide the following directly for each of the six permitted facilities (Lacpatrick Dairies, Granville Ecopark, JMW Farms, Foyle Food Group, Anaerobic Advantage, and Strathroy Dairy):

1. The annual tonnage of waste received at each facility, broken down by waste code (EWC), for the most recent reporting year and the two preceding years; and
2. The maximum permitted annual input tonnage specified in each facility's permit.”

Request 1.

After a search of our records I can confirm that these records are held for 2 of the 6 facilities listed in the request. This information has been provided.

For the remaining 4 facilities Regulation 12(4)(a) has been applied:

Regulation 12(4)(a) - Don't hold the information that has been requested.

The remaining 4 AD plants derive input from the operators adjacent / contiguous facility. Therefore there is no requirement for NIEA to retain this information.

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Request 2.

Regulation 6(1)(b) - The information is already publicly available and easily accessible to the applicant in another form or format.

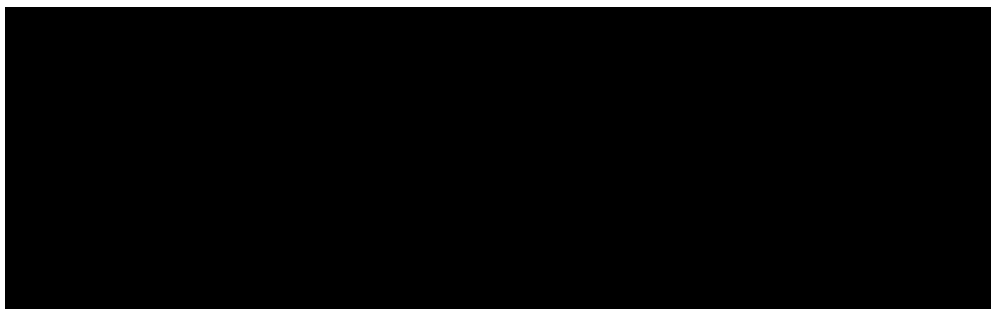

If after such an internal review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, CHESHIRE, SK9 5AF, who will undertake an independent review of the Department's decision.
