SCHEDULE 2

Regulations 1(3) and 17

EXEMPTIONS FROM WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENSING

PART I

Activities exempt from waste management licensing

14. - (1) The manufacture from -

(a) waste which arises from demolition or construction work or tunnelling or other excavations; or

(b) waste which consists of ash, slag, clinker, rock, wood, bark, paper, straw, gypsum,
of timber products, straw board, plasterboard, bricks, blocks, road stone or aggregate.

(2) The manufacture of soil or soil substitutes from any of the wastes listed in sub-paragraph (1) if -

(a) the manufacture is carried out at the place where either the waste is produced or the
manufactured product is to be applied to land; and

(b) the total amount manufactured at that place on any day does not exceed 500 tonnes.

(3) The treatment of waste soil or rock which, when treated, is to be spread on land under paragraph 9
or 11, if -

(a) it is carried out at the place where the waste is produced or the treated product is to be spread;
and

(b) the total amount treated at that place in any day does not exceed 100 tonnes.

(4) The storage of waste which is to be submitted to any of the activities mentioned in sub-paragraphs
(1) to (3) if -

(a) the waste is stored at the place where the activity is to be carried on; and

(b) the total quantity of waste stored at that place does not exceed 20,000 tonnes.
