**Environmental Information Regulation 2004**

With regard to your request for information received by the Department on 22 July 2026 which sought the following information:

*Request for environmental information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR) relating to the existing operation of Cleggan Quarry, Belcoo, County Fermanagh, and the proposed extension under planning application LA10/2026/0614/F.*

*I would be grateful if you could provide copies of, or details relating to, the period from **1 January 2010 to the present**:*

- 1. All environmental permits, licences, consents or authorisations relating to the quarry.*
- 2. All inspection reports undertaken by NIEA officers.*
- 3. All compliance assessment reports.*
- 4. Any records of non-compliance, warning letters, enforcement notices, improvement notices or prosecutions.*
- 5. All groundwater monitoring reports.*
- 6. All surface water monitoring reports.*

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7. *Any discharge monitoring records and discharge consent compliance reports.*
8. *Records relating to pollution incidents, complaints or investigations associated with the quarry.*
9. *Any environmental audits submitted by or on behalf of the operator.*
10. *Records relating to mining waste management compliance.*
11. *Any correspondence between NIEA and the operator concerning environmental compliance.*
12. *Any consultation responses provided by NIEA in relation to planning application LA10/2026/0614/F.*

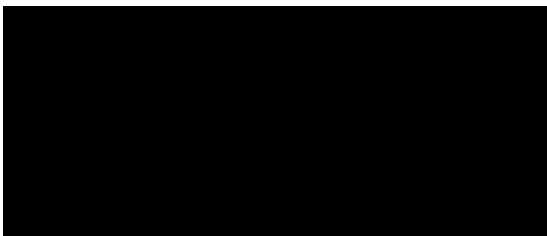
I can advise that the Department has completed its search and can confirm that it holds some of the information you requested, specifically at point 12 and which is attached as Annex A.
