Environmental Information Regulation 2004

I refer to your request for information received by the Department on 11 July 2026 which sought the following information:

Northern Ireland public drinking water supply zone details including locations, populations and water quality data for 2024 and 2025.

I can advise that the Department has completed its search and can confirm that it holds some of the information you requested.

The information held which can be disclosed is attached as **Annexes A, B, C and D**.

The Department has decided not to disclose some of the information you requested as it considers it exempted under Regulation 12(4)(d) of the Environmental Information Regulations (EIR) 2004. An associated Public Interest Test has been conducted and is attached for your information at **Annex E**.

If you are deaf or have a hearing difficulty you can contact the Department via the Next Generation Text Relay Service by dialling 18001 + telephone number.

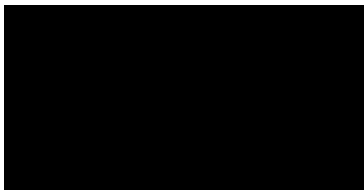
