Freedom of Information Act 2000

I refer to your request for information received by the Department on 13 July 2026 that sought the following information:

Could you please supply a copy of all correspondence (including email, letters and minutes of meetings) between DAERA and the group MPANI for the years 2024, 2025 and 2026 to date?

I can advise that the Department has completed its search and can confirm that it holds the information you requested.

The information held which can be disclosed is attached at **Annexes A to D**.

Some of the information held constitutes personal data of which you are not the data subject. In these instances, the Department is required to consider if disclosure would breach the first Data Protection Principle, which states that processing must be lawful, fair and transparent.

If you are deaf or have a hearing difficulty you can contact the Department via the Next Generation Text Relay Service by dialling 18001 + telephone number.

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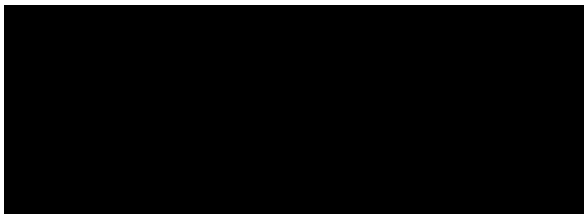

If you are unhappy with the manner in which your request for information has been handled or the decision to release/withhold information, you have the right to request a formal review by the Department. If after such an internal review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, CHESHIRE SK9 5AF, who will undertake an independent review of the Department’s decision.
