What do you want to vary on your current licence(s)?



The LirIC Project is not seeking any change to the scope of the works previously consented under Licence MLVAR2025049. The originally approved methodologies, materials, and survey activities remain unchanged.

This request relates specifically to **Part 1: Particulars, Section 5 – Survey Validity** of the Marine Survey Licence MLVAR2025049 that details the validity dates of the licence (22 January 2026 until 1st September 2026). We request that this licence validity period be amended to reflect the revised expiry date of 01 November 2026, while all other conditions and operational parameters remain unchanged.

Why do you wish to request a variation your licence(s) in this way?

Whilst survey activities have continued to progress, we have experienced a number of technical challenges during the survey programme this year which have led to an extended survey duration and reduced the available time for completion of the remaining works within the current licence period. Although we remain confident that the outstanding activities can be completed within this period, we are seeking a precautionary extension to ensure sufficient flexibility is available should additional time be required to complete the survey scope. Our offshore campaign is ongoing at the moment and is due to complete in the middle of August however if we were to encounter any unforeseen technical issues this could lead to the duration extending slightly beyond the licence period. An extension would avoid the scenario where we are almost complete but require a full demobilisation and remobilisation which would result in significant additional costs and schedule delays.

We therefore request that the licence be extended by a further two months, until 1st November 2026. We consider this to be a reasonable and proportionate extension that will provide adequate contingency to accommodate any further programme disruption while enabling completion of the remaining survey activities.

We can confirm that there are no proposed changes to the survey area, methodology or scope of works previously approved under the licence, and all activities will continue to be undertaken in accordance with the licence conditions and relevant regulatory requirements.

What date would the variation to the licence(s) come into effect?

1st September 2026 (To provide an uninterrupted continuation of the existing license validity).
