Investigation Details	Initial investigation found some discolouration (possible farm effluent) in the waterway downstream of [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] No source could be traced so couldn't say for definite that it was coming from [REDACTED] or adjacent farm. Also - the owner of the fields between [REDACTED] and the complainant had been digging / cleaning out the drain and it could have been this disturbance that he saw that triggered the complaint. Follow-up visit on 5th August found the waterway below [REDACTED] to be flowing clean with no traces of fungus. [REDACTED] had cleaned out the drain and installed brick steps below the point where it exits the piped section in order to help aerate the water.

Details

Fri 22/5 - Confirmed that the water in the stream at [REDACTED] was discoloured and appeared black.

While investigating I was recognised and approached by [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] who told me (off the record) that he had had a issue with a collapse of silage out of a silo that he was in the process of fixing and he believed that effluent from this may have gotten into the storm drains but it was now rectified and all effluent was now going to the tanks. There was evidence of fungus in the waterway downstream of his farm.

Wed 27/5 - checked waterway immediately downstream of [REDACTED] and the fungus had mostly cleared up.

Fri 29/5 - waterway immediately downstream of [REDACTED] clean but further downstream still appeared polluted and the stream down at [REDACTED] was now grey and stagnant.

Further investigations found another tributary with fungal growths on the bed. Coming from the direction of [REDACTED] at [REDACTED].

2 person visit to this premises to be arranged.

16/6 - phone call from the anon complainant to the hotline complaining of lack of updates provided.

Every time I try to update the phone goes straight to a recorded voice message saying to try again later.

Details

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] inspected farm at [REDACTED] and met [REDACTED]. A silage effluent collection tank was noted to be full and overflowing into another tank with an open outlet which ran to the waterway. Effluent channels at one of the silos were noted to be blocked and overflowing allowing effluent to escape (heavy showers on the day in question).

Reinspection on 25 June found the issues to have been attended to and the waterway much improved.
