DEPRIVATION ORDER

WHEREAS the defendant was on the 8 May 2026 convicted by Dungannon Magistrates Court of the following offences:

Charges 1-3,5,6,8,10,11,13-17 Failure To Hold A Carcass contrary to Regulation 19 of the Animal By-Products (Enforcement) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015

Charge 18 Failing To Produce Vet Medicine Records contrary to Regulation 37(d) of The Veterinary Medicines Regulations 2011

Charge 19 Failure To Comply With By-Products Notice contrary to Regulation 27(5) of The Animal By-Products (Enforcement) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015

Charges 4,7,9,12,20,21 Causing Unnecessary Suffering To Animals contrary to Section 4(1) of the Welfare of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 2011

AND the defendant is the owner of the animal in relation to which the offence was committed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the defendant be deprived of ownership of the said animal namely all animals bred or kept for farming purposes.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT (a) Appoint a person to carry out, or arrange for the carrying out of, the order, namely [REDACTED]. (b) Require any person who has possession of an animal to which the order applies to deliver it up to enable the order to be carried out; (c) Deprive [REDACTED] of the ownership of animals including those at [REDACTED] and those in herd numbers [REDACTED], and to order the disposal of these animals with immediate effect. The animals to which this order applies shall include all animals bred or kept for farming purposes. The decision about the manner of disposal shall be delegated to [REDACTED]. Under Section 32(9) the direction for disposal shall be taken to include the destruction of these animals. (d) Confer powers to [REDACTED] to carry out, or arrange for the carrying out of this order, entry to premises where the animals to which the order

applies are being kept for the purpose of, or in connection with, the carrying out of the order and to gather and dispose of the animals to which the order applies and (e) (e) order the offender to reimburse the expenses of carrying out the order to the Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs Veterinary Service Animal Health Group.

NOTHING MAY BE DONE UNDER THIS ORDER UNLESS THE PERIOD FOR GIVING NOTICE OF APPEAL AGAINST THE ORDER HAS EXPIRED, AND IF THE ORDER IS THE SUBJECT OF AN APPEAL, THE APPEAL HAS BEEN DETERMINED OR WITHDRAWN.
