With regards to your request for information received by the department 26th November, which sought the following information:

Electronic copy of all documentation submitted, issued or held on file in relation to this consent.

I can advise that the Department has completed its search and can confirm that it holds the information you requested which is attached as **Annex 1**.

We must note, that following review, this request is being processed under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 given all documentation relates to consent to discharge application within which environmental data is the core subject.

Some of the information held constitutes personal data of which you are not the data subject. In these instances, the Department is required to consider if disclosure would breach the first Data Protection Principle, which states that processing must be lawful, fair, and transparent. The Department has considered this element within the test attached.

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If you are deaf or have a hearing difficulty you can contact the Department via the Next Generation Text Relay Service by dialling 18001 + telephone number.

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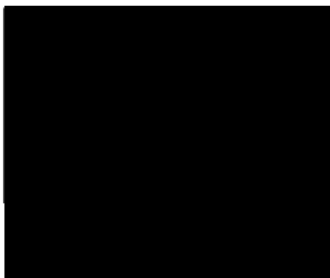
In relation to your complaint regarding the planning approval for six glamping pods versus the consent for three pods, the Department acknowledges your concerns. However, please note that the Department's assessment is based solely on the information provided within the consent to discharge application. Should the applicant decide to construct more than three glamping pods, a revised consent application would need to be submitted.

If you require any clarification, believe that any part of your request has been overlooked, misunderstood or misinterpreted, please contact me in the first instance to see if it is a matter that can be resolved. If you are unhappy with the manner in which your request for information has been handled or the decision to release/withhold information, you have the right to request a formal review by the Department.

If after such an internal review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, CHESHIRE, SK9 5AF, who will undertake an independent review of the Department's decision.
