## **Environmental Information Regulations 2004**

### **Sewage discharge applications, Loughmacrory Road**

With regard to your request for information, received by the Department on 10 August 2026 and subsequently clarified on 19 August 2026. Your clarified request relates to environmental information concerning sewage discharge consent applications within the area marked in red on the map provided by email on 13 August 2026.

You requested the following information:

*Environmental information relating to sewage discharge consent applications approved within the area subsequently identified by you on the attached map, including details of applications, consents, technical assessments, correspondence and related records.*

I can advise that the Department has now completed its searches and can confirm that it holds information falling within the scope of your request, which is attached at Annex 1.

The Department notes that environmental information relating to the area identified within your request was previously considered under Environmental Information Regulations request DAERA/25-711. Information previously disclosed in response to that request has not been reproduced within this response, as it is already publicly available. In accordance with Regulation 6 of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, that information is publicly available and can be accessed via the Department's website under reference DAERA/25-711 (response issued on 22 December 2025) along with the information disclosed as part of that response.

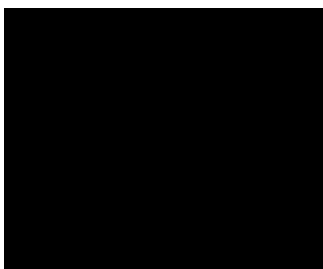
Some of the information held constitutes personal data for which you are not the data subject. This information has been withheld under Regulations 12(3) and 13(1) of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004. The Department is required to consider whether disclosure would breach the data protection principles contained within UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018, including the requirement that personal data be processed lawfully, fairly and transparently. The Department has considered this matter and its reasoning is set out in the attached Lawful Processing and Fairness Test. Where personal data has been removed from disclosed records, this has been clearly indicated. The remainder of the information held that falls within the scope of your request is released in full.

If you require any clarification, believe that any part of your request has been overlooked, misunderstood or misinterpreted, please contact me in the first instance to see if it is a matter that can be resolved. If you are unhappy with the manner in which your request for information has been handled or the decision to release/withhold information, you have the right to request a formal review by the Department.
