Environmental Information Regulations 2004

Thank you for your e-mail request for information received by the Department on 10 September 2026 in which you requested confirmation of any individual who has claimed grants/subsidies on lands at Farm Survey Number 3/079/109 Fields 1, 2 and 3.

The Department has considered your request and carried out a search of records. I can confirm that it holds information related to your request. Normally, the Department cannot provide information as to who claimed or received payment on land as such information is considered to be personal information belonging to a third party, of which, you may not be the data subject.

However, on this occasion, the third party identified has authorised the Department to provide you with the information you requested. Therefore, I can confirm that the fields referenced in your request have been included in Single Applications submitted under the Basic Payment Scheme (BPS) for the scheme years from 2021 to 2024, the Farm Sustainability Transition Payment (FSTP) for the 2025 scheme year, and the Farm Sustainability Payment (FSP) for scheme year 2026 by the farm business registered in the name of Mr. Thomas Farrell.

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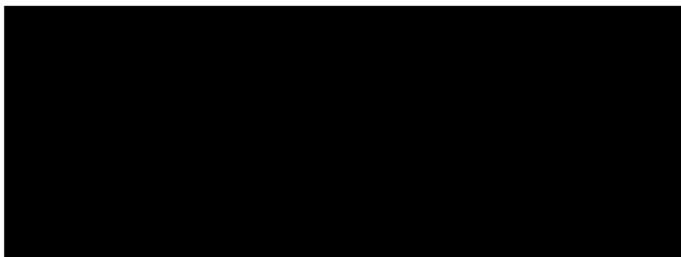
