### **Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR)**

I refer to your email received by the Department on the 12<sup>th</sup> of August 2026 requesting information on the Moy Park Litter Utilisation Strategy ("the Strategy").

I can advise the Department has completed its search and confirm it holds some of the information requested. However, some of the information has been withheld for the following reasons:

- It is considered Personal Data of which you are not the data subject. Regulation 12(3) 13(1) provides an exception from disclosure. Information regarding the names of third parties have been redacted. A Lawfulness, Fairness and Transparency Test has been conducted and is attached as Annex B.
- The information was provided in confidence and is commercial or industrial in nature. Regulation 12 (5) (e) provides an exemption for disclosure. This decision was reached after carrying out a Public Interest Test, which is attached for your information at Annex C.

The information, which the Department can disclose in relation to this request, is attached.

**1) A copy of each version Moy Park Litter Utilisation Strategy (e.g. from the July 2025 version to when it was first produced in c2014).** Copies of the July 2025, July 2021, July 2018 and November 2015 versions of the Moy Park Litter Utilisation Strategy are attached i.e. Annex A1(a) to Annex A1(d).

2) **Moy Park submits an annual summary of their litter management outlets to NIEA for audit purposes. Please provide a copy of these for each year from 2025 to back to the first one (2014?).** Copies of the 2025, 2024, 2023, 2022, 2021 and 2018 annual summaries of the litter management outlets are attached i.e. Annex A2(a) to Annex A2(f).

3) **Any memorandum of understandings, or similar document, with Moy Park related to the Strategy.** This information is not held by the Department.

4) **Any internal DAERA/NIEA guidance which explains the Strategy. This would include guidance for staff which consider PPC permit applications.** This information is not held by the Department.

5) **Any guidance documents issued to Planners in the Councils which explain the Strategy.** This information is not held by the Department.

6) **Any Internal Memo/Submission for the Minister (or Perm Sec) relating to the Strategy.** See attached Annex A3.

If you require any clarification, believe that any part of your request has been overlooked, misunderstood or misinterpreted, please contact me in the first instance to see if it is a matter that can be resolved.

If you are unhappy with the manner in which your request for information has been handled or the decision you have the right to request a formal review by the Department. If you wish to do so, please write to The Review Section, The Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs, Information Management Branch, Room 507, Dundonald House, Upper Newtownards Road, Ballymiscaw, BELFAST, BT4 3SB, within two months from the date of this letter.

If after such an internal review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, CHESHIRE SK9 5AF, who will undertake an independent review.
