

GUIDANCE FOR CERTIFYING OFFICERS, CENTRE VETS AND DAERA FIELD STAFF
DOCUMENTS AND PROCESSES TO SUPPORT CERTIFICATION
FOR MOVEMENTS AND EXPORTS OF
GERMINAL PRODUCTS
FROM AND TO
APPROVED GERMINAL PRODUCT ESTABLISHMENTS.

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1. INTRODUCTION

This document provides guidance to support the movement of germinal products within NI and from NI to GB, exports to EU and Third Countries. It assumes the establishments have been approved and comply with Reg (EU) 2020/686. It refers mostly to bovine germinal products though generic guidance can be extended to other species.

VSSPT	Veterinary Service Support Certificate	A VSSPT provides disease clearance for the diseases described within it. It does not provide blanket disease clearance for the donor or establishments. The CO must establish all disease statuses not included on the VSSPT from official authorities outside NI e.g., TB, Br, EBL and herd/flock PVPs as appropriate e.g., BVD, IBR.

3. APPLICABLE LEGISLATION

After 20/4/21, all exporting establishments must be approved and collect, process and store germinal products in compliance with Reg (EU) 2020/686.

FOR EU EXPORTS

Specific commodity requirements are translated from the above legislation to the relevant TRACES certificate for that commodity e.g.

If bovine oocytes collected 6/8/20, use BOVINE-OOCYTES/EMBRYOS-INTRA-B.

If collected 11/10/21, use BOV-SEM-INTRA-A.

If exporting product that was imported, check incoming certificate for the date of collection and Directive or Regulation that applied at the time of collection and select the relevant TRACES certificate for its onwards export e.g.

BOV-SEM-INTRA-A or B or C
