Environmental Information Regulation 2004

I refer to your request for information dated 4 August 2026 seeking the information detailed below.

1. In relation to wind turbines of 180m and 150m, can you forward documentation that outlines the carbon footprint of each of these turbines and the carbon footprint on the cabling as well.

This should include the carbon footprint they make as a result of construction and the work that needs to be done to put them in position.

Under Regulation 12(4)(a) the Department is excepted from the duty to disclose the information on the grounds that the information sought is not held.

DAERA is not responsible for the information requested. You could try contacting the Planning Office of the Local Council or the Department for the Economy who is the department responsible for renewable energy developments. They may be able to provide an answer to your query.

If you are deaf or have a hearing difficulty you can contact the Department via the Next Generation Text Relay Service by dialling 18001 + telephone number.

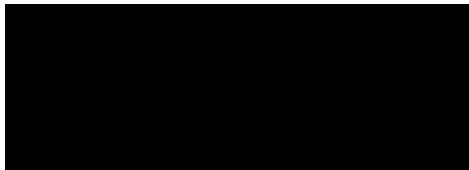

If after such an internal review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, CHESHIRE SK9 5AF, who will undertake an independent review of the Department's decision.
