Thank you for your e-mail received by the Department on 28 August 2026, in which you requested to know if lands identified in your request are presently being claimed and by whom.

I must advise that the information you requested is considered to be third party personal data which, under the terms of the Environmental Information Regulations (EIR) exceptions 12(3) 13(1) and the Data Protection Act 2018, the Department is normally constrained from releasing.

However, on this occasion, the third party has authorised the Department to provide you with the information you requested.

Therefore, I can confirm that the fields referenced above have been claimed and payment made in the 2026 scheme year to a farm business registered in the name of Mr. Emmett Conway.

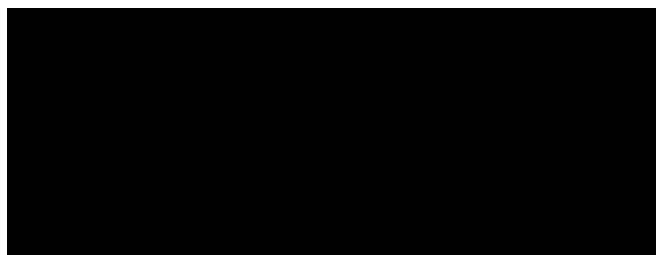

If after such an internal review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire, SK9 5AF, who will undertake an independent review of the Department's decision.
