One of The Department's proposals is that commercial tour providers who wish to operate in marine protected areas gain accreditation in a wildlife safe scheme called WiSe. This accreditation will serve as evidence that skippers of their vessels have the required knowledge and skills to observe marine wildlife safely while avoiding the risk of causing disturbance to it. On gaining accreditation The Department will issue the tour providers with a permit to operate in marine protected areas. The permit will be issued free of charge, there will however be a cost associated with the training required for the operators to gain the necessary accreditation. Carrying out wildlife tours etc. in an accredited manner however will help to conserve the marine wildlife in protected areas thus ensuring the future sustainability of the individual's business, meaning that the long-term impact to operators in a rural community is a positive one.  The policy is currently at the consultation stage, this assessment may be updated as The Department receives further information in response to the consultation.

The dependency that people from rural areas have on the marine environment was taken into consideration when developing proposed management measures in marine protected areas. At an early stage of development, The Department considered introducing prohibition zones to all vessels around certain designated features within marine protected areas. Taking this rural need into consideration however, The Department was of the view that proposed prohibition zones may adversely impact those who depend on access for their business. The Department revised its proposal, deciding instead to offer permitted access to all marine protected areas for commercial tour providers, thus supporting this rural need.			
Commercial fishing vessels will not be prohibited from accessing any zones that are prohibited to personal water craft.
