3. Have you entered at Ila the name and address of the person responsible for the exportation?		
4. Have you entered at Ilb the address of the export assembly centre from which the animals are to be exported (if different to the entry at Ila)?		
5. Have you entered at IIla the name and address of the person with responsibility for the sheep once they arrive at the premises of destination?

10. Have the identification marks of the animals been verified by the AVI practice?		
11. Have you examined the animals within 24 hours of the intended date/time of export to confirm they show no evidence of infectious or contagious disease and are fit to travel?		
12. Do you have an original signed support document GB11 SL VSSPT (EAC) from the DVO to confirm that clauses IV 1(b) and (c) can be signed in respect of the Assembly Centre? Do you also have a signed SG2 or Market G document for each animal and the OVNLIC to provide assurance regarding the individual animals and source flocks?		
13. Have you received a correctly completed ORIGINAL signed owner's/exporter's declaration* GB11 SL OD completed in respect of all animals to be exported which declares the 30 day residency in N.I. the cleansing and disinfection of the exporting vehicle and separation from animals not similarly certified, as required by the health certificate?		
14. Does the attached movement licence OVNLIC bear its serial number and the serial number of the health certificate to which it refers on each page?
