**Subject: Implementation of New Transporter Control Rules for Exports of Ungulates to the EU from 1 August 2023**

### To all TRACES NT Users

#### 1. **Implementation of Transporter Control Rules – for Exports of Ungulates to the EU effective from 1 August 2023.**

[aPVP Bulletin 03/23](#) issued on 15 June 2023 set out details about the Implementation of Control Rules – for exports of Ungulates to the EU implemented from 5 June 2023. The EU Commission has now confirmed these rules will be revised in relation to **Box I.16 Transporter** with effect from **1 August 2023**.

#### **What does this mean?**

From 1 August 2023 when completing any of the following Ungulate Intra certificates the revised **Box I.16 Transporter** control rule will be applied.

To proceed you **must** select a valid registered transporter who has a profile on TRACES NT which includes the mandatory “**Activity Types**” of **REG-TRANS** and **REG-TRANS-AUTH-II**.



Whilst you will be able to select either of these “**Activity Types**”, in the case of a long journey i.e. over 8 hours you **must** ensure you select the transporter using their **REG-TRANS-AUTH-II** activity.

As of 1 August 2023, it will no longer be possible to select transporters registered under the section **REG-TRANS-AUTH-I** when completing Box I.16.

## Existing NI Transporters on TRACES NT

In preparation for this change jointly with the EU Commission, DAERA are updating existing NI transporters profiles to add the additional **REG-TRANS** activity type.

This will result in transporters having multiple transporter activities as per the examples shown here.

As per the above guidance just select the relevant transporter activity depending on the journey type for the export.

## NI Transporters

If you have been unable to find an existing valid transporter by searching using their DAERA WIT number, and require a new transporter to be created or you identify an issue with an existing transporters profile please contact either [daeradirect.dungannon@daera-ni.gov.uk](mailto:daeradirect.dungannon@daera-ni.gov.uk) or [daeradirect.mallusk@daera-ni.gov.uk](mailto:daeradirect.mallusk@daera-ni.gov.uk)

These offices deal with transporter authorisation and will be able to validate the details prior to updating TRACES NI and will add the required transporter activities.

**Note:** DAERA will only create NI Transporters on TRACES NT who have applied for and been given WIT I and/or WIT II authorisation. Once authorised DAERA will also then add the additional **REG-TRANS** activity type to their profile.

## Future Exports

The implementation of Control Rules highlights the need especially in the case of non-NI purchasers of animals, that they **must** have the correct TRACES NT operator/transporter roles and failure to do so will delay certification at sales for animals for export from NI to EU Member States, e.g. ROI.
