1. Updated "How to Complete Pet Passports" Guidance

The previous document has been updated to reflect the following:

- Change in terminology from AVI to aPVP.
- The advice issued last year re issue of passports to GB pets in aPVP Bulletin 9/21.
- Action to re-label passports.
- To emphasise that certain tasks / preparation must be completed by an aPVP,
 i.e. issue of the passport, administration of rabies vaccine, rabies blood sampling for titre test and completion of that section of the passport.
- Updated contact details for reporting illegal imports to Trade Imports Team.
