**Subject**: Changes to the requirements for the certification of breeding and production cattle to the ROI (and other EU Member States with BVD Approved Eradication Programmes)

## Content

You will be aware that the ROI had their BVD Eradication Programme approved by the EU on 18<sup>th</sup> July 2022. The ROI are now listed as a Member State with an Approved Eradication Programme for BVD. This listing brings with it changes to the requirements for the certification of breeding and production cattle to the ROI (note certification of cattle for slaughter remains unchanged).

Trade Programme and BVD Programme held a joint webinar for practitioners on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> July 2022 to explain the changes and what these mean.
