## 10 Key Questions to ask before commencing a Section 1 Activity

- 1. Is the activity which my organisation is going to engage in subject to Section 1(1) of the Rural Needs Act (NI) 2016?
- 2. Have I read the publication A Guide to the Rural Needs Act (Northern Ireland) for Public Authorities (Revised)?
- 3. Do I understand what the due regard duty is?
- 4. Do I understand the 6 step Rural Needs Impact Assessment process?
- 5. Have I obtained a copy of the Rural Needs Impact Assessment (RNIA) Template?
- 6. Am I aware of the need to undertake a proportional Rural Needs Impact Assessment and to document each step of the process on the RNIA Template in order to help provide evidence that the due regard duty has been complied with?
- 7. Have I consulted DAERA's Rural Needs website to determine what help and support is available to me?
- 8. Do I know that advice is available from DAERA's Sustainable Rural Communities Branch, my organisation's Rural Needs Co-Ordinator and the Rural Community Network?
- 9. Have I completed Section 1 of the RNIA Template?
- 10. Have I considered which of the methods and information sources set out in Section 3 of the RNIA Template I will need to utilise in order to understand the social and economic needs of people in rural areas which are relevant to the Section 1 Activity?

You should seek to ensure that you are able to answer <u>YES</u> to all 10 questions before commencing a Section 1 Activity

**Section 1 Activity** means the development, adoption, implementation or revision of a policy, strategy or plan, or the design or delivery of a public service
