## Specification:

The 'Small bird box' must:

- be constructed according to the dimensions in the diagram below;
- have an entrance hole at least 125 mm from the floor;
- have an entrance hole depending on the species of bird that the box is intended for, that is, 25 mm for coal, marsh and blue tits, 28 mm for great tits and 32 mm for house and tree sparrows; and
- be erected and maintained as detailed in the ssRMP, for EFS(H) sites.

## **Further Advice:**


A drainage hole should be drilled in the base.

The inside front surface should be rough to allow young birds to clamber up.

Only apply wood preservative to the outside of 'Small bird boxes'.

'Small bird boxes' should be attached to a tree 2-5 m from the ground preferably facing between north and south east. When securing to a tree, use a strap made with wire and hose or rubber to minimise damage to the tree.

Do not attach 'Small bird boxes' to electricity poles.
