Introduction

- The ARD Ardstraw River Development was project proposal to reclaim and restore access to River Derg at Ardstraw Bridge
- •The Derg River is an SAC (Special Area of Conservation) habitat for salmon, otters
- Area overgrown and colonised by alien species
- Himalayan Balsam
- Grows in dense clusters and prevents smaller native plants from growing
- Project benefit river wildlife and open up Derg landscape



Project Objectives

- Inspire and encourage community to appreciate River Derg
- Educate and encourage people living in community
- Safeguard and improve existing river environment
- Provide a welcome amenity area for community




- NIEA funding


